6. Official language

The official language of the event is English. Interpretation from and into any other language must be organised by the delegations. Announcements will be made in English and Czech only. All respective documents are available in English only.

7. Entries

Entries can only be made by FIG member federations. All member federations who wish to participate must confirm their participation with the Definitive and Nominative entry forms by 29th July 2011 / 30th August 2011. At the same time, the accommodation must be paid to the OC.

Entry fee

The cost for the entry **fee is 100.- € per gymnast** per Definitive entry. The entry fee is not refundable. Entries without payment of the entry fees will be considered as invalid and will be refused.

8. Accreditation

The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the event and indicates that these individuals are permitted access. There will be access control at the entrance to each area. All participants are required to wear ID Cards at all times in the competition venue.

The Accreditation Desk will be open in the Sports Hall on Wednesday, September 28th 14.30-20.30, In next days the Competition Secretariat will serve as the Accreditation Desk. The accreditation process includes:

- verification the delegation members and their names by head of delegation
- verification entry fees, accommodation and airport transfers obligations and payments, payment of unpaid amounts
- handling in the National Anthem (on CD) and the National Flag (150 x 100 cm)
- control the gymnasts' FIG licences and passports and judges' passports
- control the all team members' insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation

Insurance

The Czech Gymnastics Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations (Section 1, article 12.10) foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

Delegation members with insufficient coverage must inform the OC in advance. The OC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations' own charge for 10.- EUR per person/day.

Cancellation: 50 % of stay costs will be refunded in case of cancellation which will be made 29.-30.8.2011, no refunds will be made in case of cancellation after 10.09.2010. (Entry fees are non-refundable in any case of cancellation.)

10. Meals

Meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) are included in the official accommodation price.

Breakfast will be served in the respective hotels from 07:00 to 09:00 hrs.

Lunch on Thursday, Friday and Saturday will be served in the restaurant adjacent to the Sports hall from 11:30 to 14:30 hrs (with lunch voucher only).

Lunch on Wednesday for the delegations arrived on Tuesday will be served in their hotels.

11. Farewell Party

The farewell party (dinner & party with DJ) will take place on Saturday, 1st October 2011 at 20:00-02:00 hours in the Eurocentrum Jablonec nad Nisou, Jiráskova 7, 466 01 Jablonec nad Nisou, Czech Republic (www.eurocentrumjablonec.cz). Casual clothing accepted.

Free admission for all those who have booked the accommodation through the Organizing Committee. Every participant will get vouchers for 2 free drinks (soft drink / beer / wine).



The return transport will be organised from Liberec and Hotel Břízky Jablonec. The hotels in Jablonec centre are in the walking distance of the Eurocentrum.

Note: In the Czech Republic the age minimum limit for purchase and consumption of alcohol is 18 years of age.

12. Transportation

The members of the participating federations must pay for their international transportation to the Jablonec nad Nisou.

The Organizing Committee will provide the return transportation from Prague Airport / train station / bus station to Jablonec nad Nisou for all those who have ordered this in the Travel schedule form and paid the costs per person (return) € 30 by 30th August 2011 at the latest.

Local Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from/to the hotels and the competition venue for all those who have booked the accommodation through the Organizing Committee.

The local transport will be provided by the „Dopravní podnik měst Liberce a Jablonce n.N.“ (Liberec and Jablonec n.N. Public Transport Company) using the special World Cup bus lines with the special timetable. The regular bus stops will be used where available or the temporary bus stops will be set up where necessary.

The World Cup accreditation card will be also valid as a travel document in the regular bus and tram public transport in both Jablonec nad Nisou and Liberec from September 28th till October 4th 2011. Please, show the personal accreditation card in the case of any control.

Bus Lines

Line S1 will operate 28.9.-1.10.2011 from Hotel Zlatý Lev Liberec to the Sports Hall Jablonec and back and the regular public bus transport stops Liberec, Poliklinika (hotel) and Jablonec n.N., Plavecký bazén (venue) will be used.

Line S3 will operate 28.9.-1.10.2011 from Hotel Merkur / Hotel Zlatý Lev Jablonec to the Hotel Břízky Jablonec via Sports Hall and back and the regular public bus transport stops Jablonec n.N., Lázně (hotels Merkur and Zlatý Lev), Jablonec n.N., Plavecký bazén (venue) and temporary bus stop Jablonec n.N., Břízky (hotel Břízky) will be used.

Line S2 will operate on 1./2.10.2011 from Hotel Zlatý Lev Liberec and from Hotel Břízky to the Eurocentrum and back and the bus stops Liberec, Poliklinika and Jablonec n.N., Břízky (hotels) and Jablonec n.N., Kamenná (Eurocentrum – Farewell party) will be used.

13. Orientation meeting

Orientation meeting will take place in the Sports hall's meeting room on Thursday, 29th September 2011 at 16:30 hrs and is compulsory for all participating delegations. The meeting will be held in English only. (Max. 2 representatives per delegation.)



14. Judges meeting

Judges meeting and the draw of judges will take place in the Sports hall's meeting room on Thursday, 29th September 2011 at 17:00 hrs and is compulsory for all participating judges. The meeting will be held in English only.

15. Welcome party with the Mayor of Jablonec nad Nisou

Welcome party with the Mayor of Jablonec nad Nisou will take place in the Chronos hall, Lučanská 2, Jablonec nad Nisou (www.sal-chronos.cz) on Thursday, 29th September 2011 at 21:00 hrs. All Heads of delegations and judges are invited, the buses will be organised from the hotels.

16. Apparatus

4 Eurotramp Trampolines (4x4 beds).

17. Warm up area

The Warm up area equipped with gym mats and another 2 Eurotramp Trampolines (4x4 beds) will be available next to the Competition hall for the training / competition groups for warming up before their scheduled training / competition.

18. Starting order

Draw of the Starting order has been done by FIG in Lausanne, Switzerland on 13th September 2011. The final Starting order will be distributed to the delegations after the Orientation meeting.

19. Competition cards and Gymnasts' profiles

Deadline for handing in the Competition cards to the Organizing Committee Office is 15.00 hrs on Thursday 29th September 2011.

Competition cards and Gymnasts' profiles for Finals must be handed in to the Organizing Committee Office no later than 13:00 hrs on Saturday 1st October 2011.

20. Medical service

Medical service will be provided by the Organizing committee, MUDr. Tomáš Krůta is the official Organizing Committee Doctor.

21. Doping controls

Doping controls will be made according the FIG and IOC regulations.



22. Opening ceremony

Opening ceremony will take place on Saturday, 1st October 2011 at 14:30 hrs. The delegations are asked to nominate 2 representatives per delegation, preferably female & male), in their national track suit.

The participants are asked to assemble in the Assembly area at 14:25 hrs.

23. Competition March-In

The competitors are asked to assemble in the Assembly area 5 minutes prior each Competition March In. They have to march-in in the competition attire..

The judges are asked to be on their panel places and welcome the competitors during each Competition March-In.

24. Winner ceremony

Only the medalists (1st-3rd place) will participate in the Winner ceremony and they have to wear the competition attire. They are asked to assemble in the Assembly area before the Winner ceremony.

Prize money

The prize money will be distributed in € per discipline as follows :

1st place	SFr. 1 500,-
2nd place	SFr. 1 000,-
3rd place	SFr. 500,-

In Synchronized Trampoline the above mentioned amounts will be distributed per synchro pair.

No prize money, medals and World Cup Series Ranking Lists points will be given, if there are less than 4 participating federations in a category.

25. TV coverage

Czech TV will broadcast live the finals on Saturday, 1st October 2011. The live broadcasting will start at 15:25 hrs and finish a 16:55 hrs.
